

Central IL Vulcan Riders Chapter Bylaws

1. Name - The name of the chapter shall be **Central IL Vulcan Riders** established May 28, 2012

2. Dues/Membership

Requirement for full membership is a legal, running Kawasaki Vulcan of any size. Membership dues become due on February 1 each year and will be \$10 Individual; \$15 Family. An Associate Membership, with voting privileges, is available to the riders of other brands of motorcycles at the same dues rate as full members. All members will be assigned a unique VRA number from the Chapter.

3. Elected Officers - Only full members may be elected to office. Term of office is one year.

An Officer's duties may not in any way be in conflict with the VRA bylaws.

President - The President is the nominal head of the chapter and is responsible for the well being of the chapter and represents the chapter as required.

Vice President - The Vice President, in general, assists the President and assumes the duties of President in the President's absence.

Secretary - The Secretary is responsible for recording the minutes of the meeting and distributing a summary to the membership. The Secretary is accountable for the safe keeping of all records and other documents relating to the Chapter.

Treasurer - The Treasurer maintains an accurate record of the chapter's finances. At each meeting, the Treasurer provides a treasury report with the chapter's balance and all transactions since the last meeting.

4. Nominations for elected office will be at the February meeting, requiring a second, and voting will be by secret ballot. If an office(s) is uncontested, then a simple majority vote may replace the balloting procedure by motion from the floor, with second. No officer can hold two elected offices at the same time.

5. Vacancy of Elected Officers- A full member can be appointed by the President (with confirmation by the Membership) to perform the duties of an office that has become vacant for any reason, for the remainder of that term. A member can temporarily hold that office until the next membership meeting is held. If the office of President becomes vacant, the Vice President will assume that position and then he will appoint a vice president to fill remainder of that term with membership approval. Removal of an officer can be made, with cause, by a majority membership vote at a meeting.

6. Appointed Officer - A member appointed by the President (with confirmation by the Membership) to perform a duty for the chapter. A member can temporarily hold an office until the next membership meeting is held. All appointed offices shall expire with the election of officers each year. Duties and term of an appointed office will be set by the President.

7. Website - The Chapter will maintain a website showing Officers' names and contact information, a printable membership application, and links to VRA Website and other VRA pages.

8. Meetings - Meetings to be held monthly from April through October with Winter Meetings in November and February.

9. Effective Date of these Bylaws is March 20, 2015 by the Officers to make clarifications.
